### NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

Fleeces may be housed or unhoused, must be skirted and not more than thirteen months growth. Fleeces to be delivered to the Dubbo Showground, cnr Wingewarra & Fitzroy Streets, Dubbo by **9.00am Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023. *Delivery of fleeces on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> August would be appreciated.*** Exhibits may be collected after 3.00pm on Wednesday 23rd August 2023. **Please deliver fleeces in a plastic bag with Exhibitor's name, address and class for entry inside the bag.** Points will be awarded 3-2-1 for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. **PRIZES**

Trophies and ribbons will be awarded for each class. Details will be published in the Catalogue prior to close of entries.

**FLOCK GROWERS SECTION (UNHOUSED FLEECES ONLY)**  
**(Registered Studs are not eligible)**

17. Fine Ewe or Wether

**Commercial Value**

20. Fleece of any quality. May be rugged or unrugged. Fleece to be skirted. To be judged on a commercial value basis. Fleeces will be objectively measured, courtesy of Mr Don Chad, **Chad Wool**, Dubbo.

**SPECIAL CLASS- ULTRAFINE**

21. Superfine/Ultrafine Merino fleece best quality and style-product.  
Skirted fleece, either Ram or Ewe or Wether's wool. 74's quality & above.

**Conditions:** Open to skirted fleeces grown anywhere in Australia. They must be of one season's growth (approximately 12 months) and not weigh less than 2.25kg however no points will be allocated for weight.

**Judging Scale** (*for class 21 only*): Character & style 40, Length 25, Yield 5, Fineness 25. Total of 95 points. In addition a maximum of 5 points may be awarded for fleeces of Superfine quality. The basis will be 74's and up 2, 80's and up 3, 90's and up 4 points.
