#### PLEASE READ CONDITIONS OF THE NATIONAL SHEEP SHOW CAREFULLY

- 1. Entry Fee: SHOW ONLY \$44 per entry and Groups and Pairs \$11 (includes GST)
- 2. Limit on Entries: 5 entries per stud per class extra entries \$55 each (includes GST)
- 3. All sheep to be shorn in accordance with the NSWSMB Association regulation as at 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025. Only 2024 and 2025 Association ear tags will be accepted.
- 4. Shearing inspection certificates from all inter-state exhibitors to be presented to the Chief Steward prior to 9.00am Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 5. All sheep must be from an Accredited Brucellosis Free Flock.
- 6. All Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water containers
- 7. All Exhibitors to collect entry cards by 9.00am Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 8. NVD's must be provided to a committee member prior to sheep being unloaded.
- 9. All sheep entered for show must remain in their pens until the completion of judging unless being taken out for judging. Show sheep may come from static displays.
- 10. ALL sheep, show and Display must be penned by 7.30am Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025. A fee may be incurred by late arrivals.
- 11. No sheep to be removed prior to the conclusion of the Rabobank Supreme Australian Merino Ram Event on the evening of Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2025 or the morning of Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 12. All sheep must be reflective of stud registration (ie horn or polled) with a relevant State Stud Merino Breeder Association.
- 13. All poll sheep must be inspected prior to judging and must conform to Poll definitions.
- 14. All Merino rams entered into the show must display a full set of horns.
- 15. All classes to include Merinos and Polls will be judged separately
- 16. The City of Dubbo Group may be selected from classes 1 24b and must be bred and owned by the same registered stud
- 17. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Ram & Ewe to be selected from all Championship winners
- 18. Supreme Exhibit to be selected from all Championship winners
- 19. Supreme and Groups to be judged by all judges
- 20. Points for the most successful exhibitor shall be awarded as follows: Single Class, Pair 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd, 3rd; Points 3, 2, 1. Champions and Grand Champions Points 2. Reserve Champions Points 1. City of Dubbo Group 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd, 3rd; Points 5, 4, 3.
- 21. Allocation of award ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup> place. Group Classes to 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- 22. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to provide handlers for all entries.
- 23. All trophies and awards to be collected at the presentation on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 24. All Poll Merino entries must be from a Registered Poll Merino Stud.
- 25. Sheep will be judged in the class the exhibitor has nominated, but the exhibitor has the right to ask the judge (via the Chief Steward) for classification upon arrival or during inspection on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- 26. A State Representative Ram in the Supreme Exhibit cannot be entered in single classes but is eligible for pairs and groups.
- 27. All Display sheep with weights above will need weights confirmed. Weighing will commence Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August 2025 at 11.30am. Weighing will be carried out by members of the Dubbo National Ram Sale Committee.
- 28. All sheep entered in classed 1-27 must be bred and owned by the same registered stud.
- 29. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to present for judging when called.

## **NATIONAL SHEEP HEALTH DECLARATION - EXPLANATORY NOTES**

### Overview

Completing this National Sheep Health Declaration (NSHD) will assist prospective buyers to make an informed decision about the health status and management history of these sheep. The NSHD is mandatory for all sheep movements in SA and for sheep being moved into NSW and Tasmania. It is voluntary in other states.

## **Livestock Production Assurance (1)**

Livestock Production Assurance (LPA) program accreditation means that a property must have a biosecurity plan for the property. The National Farm Biosecurity Reference Manual for Grazing Livestock Production can be used to develop plans or further information including templates is available at:

### Footrot (3 and 4)

- 3. Virulent footrot is defined differently in each state. For information on this and interstate movements of sheep, producers should visit the relevant state department website or contact animal health staff from that department.
- 4. If answered Yes, all mobs should have been checked during at least one spread period, and any lameness investigated, with no symptoms of the disease observed. If answered no, producers can add any information about the disease and their management of it; e.g. whether any testing has been carried out, or what treatments may have been used recently.

### Lice (5)

All mobs should be checked for lice at least twice each year. Any sheep seen with rubbed fleece or pulled wool should be checked for lice as a matter of urgency. Further information is available at: <a href="https://www.paraboss.com.au">www.paraboss.com.au</a>

### **Approved Vaccinate (7)**

A sheep that is identified by an NLIS (sheep) 'V' tag and is:

- vaccinated with an approved JD vaccine by 16 weeks of age, OR
- vaccinated with an approved JD vaccine after 16 weeks of age, when the flock:
  - was in the SheepMAP, or
  - had undertaken a negative Faecal 350 test in the two (2) years preceding the vaccination, or
  - had a Negative Abattoir 500 status at the time of vaccination.

## SheepMAP (8)

An audited quality assurance program incorporating a property biosecurity plan, animal health risk assessment, testing, and movement controls that provide a source of low risk animals. Note - the level of testing varies depending on the status. Date of last test should be recorded in Q9.

## Types of tests that may be recorded (9)

Faecal 350: A test of 350 representative sheep over 2 years of age (or all sheep over 2 years of age in smaller flocks) by Pooled Faecal Culture (PFC) or High Throughput Johne's (HT-J) PCR in pools of up to 50 sheep. The sheep must have been on the property for at least 2 years.

Abattoir 500: At least 500 sheep, over 2 years of age, have been submitted to an abattoir in the past 24 months, in 1 or more lots, have been examined and all found negative for JD. The sheep must have been on the property for at least 2 years.

**Abattoir 150:** At least 150 sheep, over 2 years of age, have been submitted to an abattoir in the past 12 months, in 1 or more lots, have been examined and all found negative for JD. The sheep must have been on the property for at least 2 years.

### JD management practices (10)

Any other management practices carried out for JD could be recorded here; e.g. types of introductions to the flock, or veterinary investigations.

## Other relevant health information (11)

Any other information that a producer thinks may be relevant can be recorded here; e.g. participation in an active grower group, One Biosecurity, or other biosecurity initiatives, mulesing status, pain relief usage, etc.
